Official Rules

The Valletta Waterfront will host an interactive QR Code Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, 4th April 2026, starting at 10:30 AM. By participating, you agree to the following:

Participation & Registration

The hunt is open to all young explorers aged 3 and up. For the safety of all participants, children must be accompanied by a supervising parent or guardian at all times and are strictly not to be left unattended. All children remain the sole responsibility of their parent or guardian throughout the activity. To take part, you must register via the link found on www.vallettawaterfront.com/easter or Facebook page. Participants are responsible for providing their own mobile device with QR scanning capabilities and active internet connectivity.

The Hunt Mechanics

The goal is to explore the promenade and find the hidden 2D PVC Easter eggs. For your safety, do not climb on any structures, go down any stairs, or approach the water's edge. Each egg features a unique QR code which must be scanned using your own mobile phone or app in any order. Please play fair and be mindful of other children; fighting, bullying, or rough play will not be tolerated, and parties involved may be asked to discontinue their participation.

Winners & Prizes

The system will record your completion and total time. The participant who scans all required codes in the fastest time will be the winner, with those in 2nd and 3rd place also receiving a special prize. Additionally, chocolate eggs will be distributed to all participants while stocks last to ensure as many children as possible enjoy the activity.

Weather & Safety

Because the safety of our participants is our top priority, the organizer reserves the right to postpone or cancel the activity in the event of rain or adverse weather conditions. We encourage everyone to enjoy the hunt in a safe manner while exploring the historic and scenic promenade of the Valletta Waterfront.
